

Sentence is a set of words which are grammatically or meaningfully arranged to convey an answer to a question or it can be statement like:

India is my country.

Sentence has subject and predicate. There are 4 types of sentence.

1. Assertive or declarative sentence
2. Imperative sentence
3. Interrogative sentence
4. Exclamatory sentence

1. Assertive or declarative sentence means which declares a feeling or opinion or incident which you surely assert about. Assertive sentence can be affirmative that is positive or negative. Ex:

- I am an Indian.
- I am studying in Ist B.com.
- I am not going to college today.
- Cauvery college is in Virajpet, kodagu.

2. Imperative sentence: conveys request, command, order. This sentence can be both affirmative that is positive or negative. Ex:

- Please maintain silence.
- Do not smoke inside the hall
- Switch off your mobile.
- Pre – heat the oven before baking.

3. Interrogative sentence :means a sentence which asks questions and ends with a question mark. Ex:

- Why are you late to college today?
- Why where you absent yesterday?

4. Exclamatory sentence: is an assertive sentence but it is expressed with emotion or excitement. It can be happy sentence or sad sentence. Ex:

- Wow! We have won the match
- Oh, God! You have scared me.
- Hurray! Exams have been cancelled.
- I got the tickets to IPL!
